

# Monsoon Session Ends Before Schedule, Low on Productivity; RS Clears 4 Bills

New Delhi: The monsoon session of Parliament that ended a few days before schedule on Monday was a near washout as the Opposition disrupted proceedings over the issue of price rise, leading to passage of only seven Bills in the Lok Sabha and four in the Rajya Sabha in 16 sittings.



Parliament was adjourned sine die on Monday evening, marking an end to the monsoon session, which was to end on August 12, four days before schedule. A total of 16 sittings took place in both Houses but the Lok Sabha proceedings were held for a total of only 44 hours and 29 minutes. The Rajya Sabha, where the Opposition is more belligerent, met for only 33 hours, as 47 hours were wasted due to protests and adjournments.

23 Opposition members were suspended from the House for remainder of the week in the Rajya Sabha for causing disruptions. Chairman M Venkaiah Naidu said he would revoke their suspension only if the erring members who had displayed placards in the Well of the House, raised slogans, and tried to film the proceedings on their mobile cameras expressed regret.

In the Lok Sabha, four Congress members were suspended for protesting in the Well on the issue of price rise and increase or imposition of Goods and Services Tax on some essential commodities. Even as Congress members protested on the streets against summoning of interim party president Sonia Gandhi by the Enforcement Directorate, other Opposition parties like TMC, Left, AAP among others, carried on the protest inside the House.

New Delhi: Rajya Sabha members cutting across party lines bid a fond farewell to ex-officio Chairman and Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu in the House on Monday, recalling his ready wit, alliterations and one-liners as well as his impartiality, encouragement to new MPs, promotion of the use of mother tongue and other virtues.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi initiated the farewell with an appreciation of Naidu's contribution to the House and the nation as Vice President. He said it is an emotional moment for the House and many thank his events took place in the dignified presence of Naidu in the Chair.

Addressing the House at the end of the farewell speeches, Naidu said he did not get any "great enjoyment" in naming members or taking "extreme action". "I have no ill-will against anybody or any party," he said. He also remembered the day Modi and Amit Shah informed him in the BJP Parliamentary Board meeting he would be the VP candidate. "I had tears in my eyes. I did not want it," Naidu said, explaining that his eyes had welled up as he had to resign

## COURT REMANDS RAUT TO 14-DAY JUDICIAL CUSTODY

Mumbai: A special court here on Monday remanded Shiv Sena MP Sanjay Raut to 14-day judicial custody in a money laundering case linked to alleged irregularities in the redevelopment of Patra chawl. The probe agency Enforcement Directorate argued that the release of Raut at this stage will hamper the investigation as he is a very influential person and it is feared that he may tamper with the evidence. Raut was produced before special PMLA court Judge MG Deshpande after the expiry of his 15-day custody on Monday afternoon. The federal probe agency did not seek further extension of his custody. The court allowed Raut's plea for home food and medicines but refused to pass an order on his prayer for bedding. The judge said as per the prison manual, jail authorities make adequate bed arrangements. -PTI

## SC Lawyer Writes to AG Seeking Consent for Initiating Contempt Action Against Sibal

New Delhi: Reacting to recent remarks made by senior advocate Kapil Sibal on the Indian judiciary, a Supreme Court lawyer has written a request letter to the Attorney General for consent to proceeding with criminal contempt of court against Sibal. Advocate Vineet Jain has alleged that Sibal, with his remarks, has scandalized the Indian judiciary and disgraced its dignity. Meanwhile, Dr Adish C Aggarwala, Senior Advocate and Chairman of All India Bar Association (AIBA) has termed Sibal's statement 'contemptuous'. Aggarwala said, "Criminal cases which were instituted by the then Governments as a political witch-hunt, where detailed investigations have been carried out but failed to disclose any evidence, had to be given a burial and if that has happened, no fault

can be found with the judicial system. Courts are not to deliver judgments hanging people just to assuage the feelings of a certain community." In a press statement, he added "Sibal is an integral part of the justice dispensation system. However, if he actually feels a loss of hope in the institution, then he is free to appear before the courts". On August 6, speaking at an event Sibal stirred a row by saying that he has lost hope in the Indian judiciary. "This year I will not appear before the courts. I have no hopes from the institution. You talk about progressive judgments delivered by the Supreme Court but there is a huge difference of what happens at the ground level. Supreme Court judge judgement on privacy and ED officers come to your home. Where is your privacy? Sibal reportedly said.

## SC Notice to Centre on plea Seeking Law on Population Control

New Delhi: The Supreme Court Monday sought responses from the government on a plea seeking directions to evaluate the feasibility of enacting a stringent population control law to secure fundamental rights for citizens. The notice was issued as a petition filed by spiritual guru Devkinandan Thakur. The petitioner contended that there is a need to control the population explosion to secure the basic rights of citizens as this is the root cause of all the problems. It might be mentioned here that a petition seeking similar relief is already hanging fire in the top Court. The Supreme Court ordered that Thakur's petition be tagged with the pending petition.

## ACCUSED OF USING CRYPTO TO FUND TERROR NIA Gets Custody of ISIS 'Active Member' Till 16th

New Delhi: The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has got custody of an alleged ISIS operative Mohsin Ahmed till August 16, a day after he was picked up after a nation-wide probe into the terror outfit's network in India. The agency has alleged that Ahmed was involved in gathering funds from India and abroad for ISIS commanders based in Syria and had been successfully evading attention till now by using technology to cover his tracks. The operative is alleged to have used cryptocurrency to raise and transfer funds for the terror organisation. The NIA arrested Ahmed from Batla House in the national capital on Saturday and described

him as a radicalised and active member of the ISIS. He was allegedly involved in online and on ground activities of the banned organisation. He was produced before the NIA court in Patna House on Monday that granted remand to the agency for further investigation. On July 28, the agency conducted a nation-wide crackdown on suspected ISIS (Islamic State) modules, with raids across six states. Investigations into the activities of the banned group were conducted after a case was registered suo moto by the agency in June. The massive operation was carried out at 13 premises across the states, with searches conducted in Bhoga and Raibew in Madhya Pradesh, Bihar's Arariya district and Kolhapur and Nanded districts of Maharashtra.

## BJP Govt Waived ₹10L-Cr Loan of Rich Friends: Kejriwal

New Delhi: Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal slammed Prime Minister Narendra Modi over the "free credit" money without naming him and alleged that the BJP government had written off loans of rich friends worth ₹10 lakh crore. He demanded that a law be brought to declare this as treason. "An environment is being created in the country that the state governments are going bankrupt because they are providing freebies to the aam saadmi (common man)," Kejri-

wal said on Monday. "They are trying to create an impression that free education in our government schools should be stopped. In the 75th year of India's independence an impression is being created that giving free treatment to the poor is putting unnecessary financial burden on the government." Kejriwal questioned the justification for providing free electricity to ministers and not to ordinary people. "It is wrong with providing free electricity and free water supply? Providing free electricity to the aam saadmi is a crime but providing free electricity to ministers is OK."
